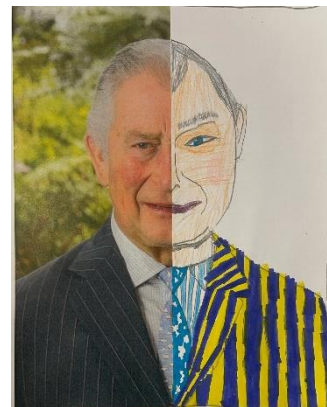


KS2 had a great day at Matlock Farm meeting all of the animals and playing together on the playground.

## Year 6 Leavers 2022/2023

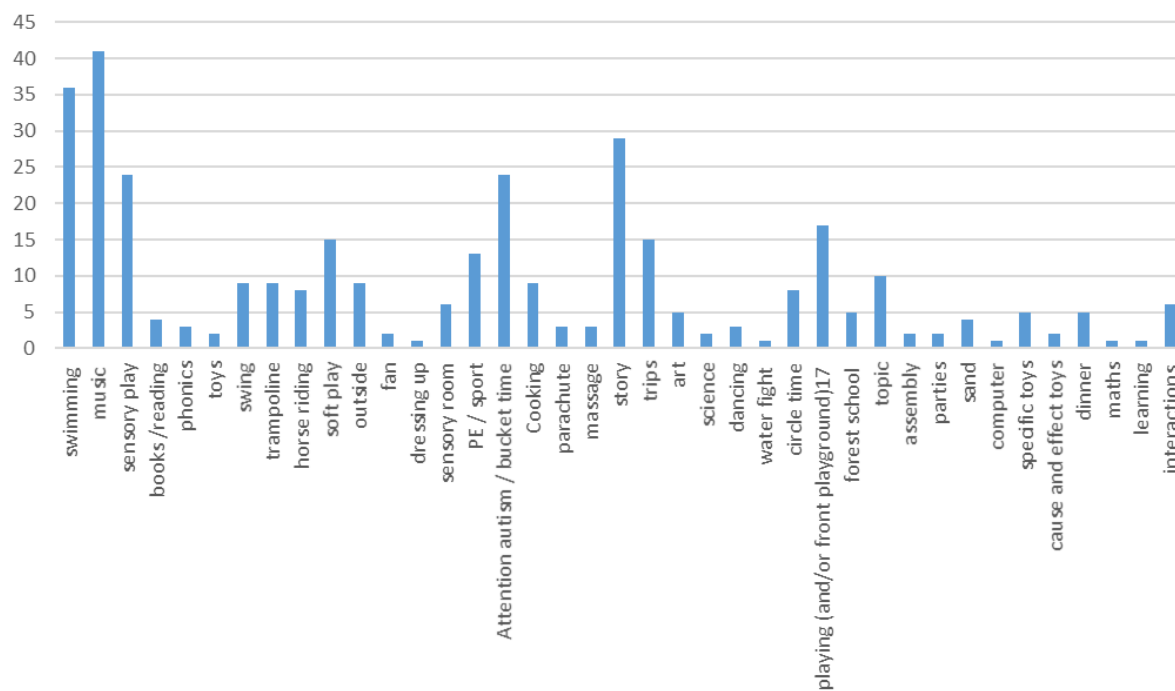
*Fox Class – Keep being you Darah, the class won't be the same without you!*
